# Langley Environmental Partners Society (LEPS)

- Education program – hundreds of workshops to thousands of student
- Festival of the Bees every May
- Promotion of iNaturalist through events
- Other fun stuff:

  - community gardens (485 plots over 10 gardens)
  - workshops and camps (kids and adults)
  - water quality project testing for coliforms
  - rain barrels and water conservation promotion

# Little Campbell Watershed Society (LCWS)
